This plan will outline the basic considerations for arriving at fire incidents. This plan may be modified by the Incident Commander as necessary.

Apparatus Placement

- Pumper – fire attack
- Ladder Truck – aerial master stream
- Rescue – Rapid Intervention Crew
- Air Tender – air supply – upwind
- Scene approach
 - 1st due vs. 2nd due apparatus
 - Alternate direction to avoid congestion

Hydrant Location

- Supply hose placement
 - Affect on apparatus placement / movement


Staging

- Level I
 - Firefighters
 - POVs
- Level II
 - Uncommitted apparatus
 - POVs
- EMS
 - Rehab – near or part of Staging

Incident Action Plan – Attack Mode

- Offensive vs. Defensive strategy
- Transitional vs. Positive Pressure Attack (PPA)
