This plan will outline the equipment carried on apparatus of the Troy Fire Department. While this list is not inclusive, it is to be considered the minimum complement of equipment.

- I. Extension ladders
  - A. 24' or 35' extension ladder
  - B. 14' roof ladder with hooks
  - C. 10' folding attic ladder
  
- II. Hose
  - A. 1 ¾" 800' total.
    - 1. 2 each preconnects 200' in length
    - 2. minimum of 400' in hose bed
  
  - B. 2 ½" 600' total.
    - 1. 1 each preconnect, 200' in length
    - 2. 400' minimum in hose bed
  
  - C. 5" 875' total
    - 1. 8 100' lengths in hose bed
    - 2. 1 25' and 1 50' for hydrant line in compartment
  
- I. Radios
  - A. Mobile radio with pump panel remote, or 1 portable with headset
  - B. 4 each portable radios
  
- II. Self Contained Breathing Apparatus
  - A. 4 each complete units
  - B. 4 each spare cylinders
  - C. 2 each SCBA face pieces
  
- III. Nozzles
  - A. 2 ½"
    - 1. 1 each 2 ½" playpipe with handles and shutoff
    - 2. 1 each Elkhart SM30 nozzle head for playpipe
    - 3. 1 each stacked tips 1", 1 1/8", 1 ¼" for playpipe
    - 4. 1 each Elkhart low pressure breakapart nozzle on preconnect
