This plan will outline the equipment carried on ladder trucks of the Troy Fire Department. While this list is not inclusive, it is to be considered to be the minimum complement of equipment.

I. Ladders

- A. 1 each 10' folding attic ladder
- B. 2 each 16' roof ladder with hooks
- C. 1 each 14' combination ladder
- D. 1 each 24' extension ladder
- E. 1 each 35' extension ladder

II. Hose

- A. 1 ½" 800' total
 - 1. 2 each 1 ¾" preconnected lines, 200' in length
 - 2. 400" minimum in hose bed
- B. 2 ½" 600' total
- C. 5" 875 total
 - 1. 8 100' lengths in hose bed
 - 2. 1 25' and 1 50' for hydrant line on compartment

III. Radios

- A. Mobile radio with pump panel remote, or 1 portable with headset
- B. 2 portable radios with chargers

IV. Self Contained Breathing Apparatus

- A. 6 each complete units with PAL device
- B. 6 each spare cylinders
- C. 2 SCBA air line hoses (for aerial operations)
- D. 2 each SCBA facepieces

V. Nozzles

- A. 2 ½"
 - 1. 2 each Elkhart 2 ½" playpipes with shut off
 - 2. 2 each Elkhart SM30 heads for play pipe
 - 3. 2 each sets stacked tips, 1", 1 1/8", 1 1/4" for playpipe
