The fire department is adding additional tools to our inventory. We have purchased the Dewalt 12volt cordless screwdriver and bit set for each station. This is to be used for various tasks including extrications, overhaul and investigations or anywhere it can assist.

Provided below is a brief description:

The DEWALT 1/4 in. 12 Volt Cordless Screwdriver Kit features a variable-speed motor that generates up to 1,050 RPM for powerful driving action. The 1/4 in. hex chuck loads with one hand and accepts 1 in. bit tips and the three LED lights provide visibility without shadows. At only 2.2 lb., this driver offers a compact, lightweight design to fit into tight areas. The kit includes two 12 Volt Max batteries, a fast charger, a bit tip, a belt hook and a contractor carrying case.

- Variable speed motor generates up to 1,050 RPM
- One-handed loading 1/4 in. hex chuck accepts 1 in. bit tips
- Compact, lightweight design at only 2.2 lb. to fit into tight areas
- Three LED lights provide visibility without shadows
- Belt hook for convenience and portability
- Uses lithium ion batteries for reliability
- Batteries recharge in 40 minutes to minimize user down time
